AIASF'S Gallery Space is 1,871-square feet, and can facilitate meetings and events of up to 195 attendees. The Gallery offers a flexible open floor plan with movable walls, allowing a multitude of potential seating configurations. The space is easily configured for parties, lectures, classes and workshops, and includes use of our 4 ceiling-mounted digital projectors and the ability to record your programming for future use for a small fee.
